IT IS ORDERED that should the attorney wish to have additional parties participate in the video conference, the attorney shall advise the Court not less than 3 days prior to the scheduled hearing by faxing a letter to the Clerk of Court at the following numbers:

Civil Cases: Fax 504-364-2613

**IT IS ORDERED** that counsel participating in the hearing via video conference shall use profiles that identify the participant by name.

IT IS ORDERED that the presence of anyone without consent of the Court is prohibited.

**IT IS ORDERED** that any recording of oral argument, by audio, video, transcription, or any other means, is strictly prohibited.

IT IS ORDERED that counsel shall be properly attired to participate in video conferences.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that violations of the foregoing shall be punishable by contempt of court.
