**STANDING ORDER FOR THE SECOND PARISH COURT**  
**VIDEO CONFERENCE**

WHEREAS, the Supreme Court of Louisiana in its Order of March 16, 2020 did urge all Courts of Louisiana to utilize teleconferencing and videoconferencing technologies;

Attorneys may attend Arraignments, Motion Hearings, Rule Hearings, Pre-Trials and Trials by video conference, provided the attorney complies with the following:

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that the attorney shall adhere to the Louisiana Supreme Court Rules.

**IT IS ORDERED** that should the attorney wish to have additional parties participate in the video conference, the attorney shall advise the Court not less than 3 days prior to the scheduled hearing by faxing a letter to the Clerk of Court at the following numbers:

Criminal Cases: Fax 504-364-3431

Civil Cases: Fax 504-364-2613

**IT IS ORDERED** that counsel participating in the hearing via video conference shall use profiles that identify the participant by name.

**IT IS ORDERED** that the presence of anyone without consent of the Court is prohibited.

**IT IS ORDERED** that any recording of oral argument, by audio, video, transcription, or any other means, is strictly prohibited.

**IT IS ORDERED** that counsel shall be properly attired to participate in video conferences.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that violations of the foregoing shall be punishable by contempt of court.
